Toronto Monthly Market Regulations

- 1. There must be a professional approach to merchandising & presentation of stalls.
- 2. If there are damages to the venue due to negligence of the stall holder/retailer, costs will be invoiced & paid by the stallholder/retailer.
- 3. Product security is the responsibility of the stall holder/retailer
- 4. There must only be 1 business per stall without prior approval of Toronto Chamber of Commerce Board.
- 5. Stallholders/retailers have their own Public Liability Insurance of \$20 Million (this is not product liability plus public liability).
- 6. Stall holders/retailers may NOT distribute or display any marketing information on market day other than their own business without prior approval of Toronto Chamber of Commerce.
- 7. No refund will be given for cancellations. If notice is given no less than 1 week prior to market date we will TRY to move you to another market date if a valid reason is given
- 8. The stallholder/retailer hereby indemnifies & holds Toronto Chamber of Commerce & its owners harmless against all claims or loss arising from connection with or in relation to the market
- 9. All products should adhere to Australian Safety Standards.
- 10. All stallholders/retailers must give Toronto Chamber of Commerce permission to use their images, business name & website text for Toronto Chamber of Commerce promotional use
- 11. Payment for your stall at Toronto Chamber of Commerce must be paid within 7 days of receiving your successful applicant email.
- 12. Only products listed & approved by Toronto Chamber of Commerce may be sold at Toronto Chamber of Commerce. If you wish to add new products please just let us know.
- 13. Stallholders/retailers are responsible for leaving their stall site & surrounding area clean & tidy as they found it. Please store your rubbish (boxes/papers etc) & then take them home with you.
- 14. Stallholders/retailers must confine their displays & signs to their stall site & keep walkways clear for customers.
- 15. Stalls using marquees or umbrellas must be secured or weighted down at all times (concrete, sand or water weights), signs and fixtures must also be secured against wind gusts.
- 16. Food stallholders/retailers must be registered with the Lake Macquarie City Council & have the appropriate insurance & licenses.
- 17. Bump in will be from 7am (not before) suitable parking site at either the grass verge near Toronto Royal Motor Yacht Club, or the Council Car Park near Woolworths.
- 18. Bump out Stall holders/ retailers must NOT pack up until 3pm but may stay later if you wish.
- 19. Toronto Chamber of Commerce accepts no responsibility for adverse weather & no refunds will be given for this reason, however at the discretion of Toronto Chamber of Commerce a credit maybe given for a future market.
- 20. Toronto Chamber of Commerce has the right to withdraw the right to trade of any stallholder/retailer in dispute with Toronto Chamber of Commerce or any persons.
- 21. Toronto Chamber of Commerce has the right to reject any stallholder/retailer who they believe does not comply with the stated regulations.
